Winter Seed Sowing Workshop Saturday, Jan 20 or Sat. Jan 27 10:00-11:00am

Michigan native seeds do best when sown in the winter. At this workshop you will learn all that you need to know in order to do your own winter sowing project. All supplies you need in order to sow two types of native seeds will be included. More supplies are available for a small additional fee.

This is a residential side street, not the Woodward that runs through Detroit). From Woodward, turn right (North) on N. Oak Street. From N. Oak St. turn left (West) on North Hill Circle. North Hill Circle will dead-end in the Dinosaur Hill parking lot.
